

SAFER PLAYGROUNDS

Proper Supervision

- Stop unsafe behaviors
 - Bullying
 - Fighting
 - Throwing inappropriate objects
 - Using equipment improperly or unsafely
 - Eating, chewing gum
 - Encroaching moving equipment (swings)
 - Overcrowding equipment
- Wander and rove
- Make eye contact
- Don't be distracted
- Create playground rules
- Keep rules short and simple
- No skates, long strings, jump ropes, cables, helmets or toys on equipment
- Report to administration when needed

Avoid Claims of Negligence

- Provide reasonable care
- Inform and warn when needed
- Correct behaviors when needed
- Provide undistracted supervision
- Provide safe facilities
- Provide safe equipment
- Provide prompt post-injury care
- Include labels that comply with the description found in Section 14 of ASTM F1487

Pre-Play Check

- Remove foreign matter
 - Dirt
 - Feces
 - Trash
 - Water
- Remove foreign objects
 - Glass
 - Rocks
 - Trash
- Check for equipment safety
 - Damaged / broken components
 - Missing or protruding fasteners
 - Sharp edges or points
 - Hot surfaces
 - Missing components
 - Excessive wear, rust
